Welcome to Kitty and the first term of 2016.

Children who stay full day sleep between 13.00 and 14.20.

We have a programme and syllabus to complete each term.

It is disruptive and unfair to the other children and to the Teachers to have parents arrive when lessons are in progress.

When children arrive late they miss out on work already done as it is not always possible to repeat the work for late comers.

The main gates will be locked from 8am (Security is important) Ring the bell at the pedestrian gate.

Please always make sure the gates are securely locked behind you on entering and leaving. Keep cars locked at all times.

The Blue and Green Class teachers request that the children have breakfast at home. Early lunch is at 10.30am

Late lunch is at 2.30pm. Please do a little research on “Two Minute Noodles” it really is not a healthy option.

Please remember to sign in and out on the Class Register on the class doors every day.
